Committee on Equality and Non-Discrimination

Synopsis No 2012/1

The Committee on Equality and Non-Discrimination, meeting in Strasbourg from 23 to 26 January 2012, first with Ms Err (Luxembourg, SOC), oldest member present, and then Ms Acketoft (Sweden, ALDE) and Mr Mendes Bota (EPP/CD) in the Chair,

held an exchange of views with the President of the Parliamentary Assembly, Mr Jean-Claude Mignon (France, EPP/CD).

As regards:

- Election of the Bureau of the Committee: elected by acclamation:
- Ms Acketoft (Sweden, ALDE) as Chairperson,
- Ms Konečná (Czech Republic, UEL), Mr Mendes Bota (Portugal, EPP/CD) and Ms Wurm (Austria, SOC) as Vice-Chairpersons;¹
- Standing sub-committees: constituted the following standing sub-committees:
 - on gender equality,
 - on the rights of minorities,
 - on racism and xenophobia,

and approved the terms of reference of the former two;

General rapporteurs:

- determined the terms of reference of a *general rapporteur on violence against women*, asked its Chairperson to submit them to the Bureau for approval and appointed Mr Mendes Bota (Portugal, EPP/CD) as general rapporteur, subject to approval of the terms of reference by the Bureau and their ratification by the Assembly, according to Rule 49.7 of the Assembly's Rules of procedure:
- determined the terms of reference of a *general rapporteur on the rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender persons (LGBTs)*, asked its Chairperson to submit them to the Bureau for approval and decided to postpone the appointment of this general rapporteur to its next meeting, subject to approval of the terms of reference by the Bureau and their ratification by the Assembly according to Rule 49.7 of the Assembly's Rules of procedure;
- **Committee's priorities for 2012**: held an exchange of views on the basis of a discussion paper presented by its Chairperson;
- The role of UN Women in promoting women's rights: held an exchange of views with Ms Michelle Bachelet, United Nations Under-Secretary-General and Executive Director of UN Women;
- Advancing women's rights worldwide (Rapporteur: Ms Err, Luxembourg, SOC): took position on the amendments tabled to the draft resolution:
- Promoting the Council of Europe Convention on preventing and combating violence against women and domestic violence (*Rapporteur: Mr Mendes Bota, Portugal, EPP/CD*): took position on the amendments tabled to the draft resolution;
- PACE Network of contact parliamentarians committed to combating violence against women: held a meeting of the Network, during which a hearing on 'so-called honour crimes' was organised with the participation of Ms Thibault, President of the NGO Surgir (Switzerland), Ms Siddiqui, Policy and Research officer at the NGO Southall Black Sisters (United Kingdom) and Ms Liri Kopaçi-Di Michele, Head of Division at the Justice and Human Dignity Directorate of the Council of Europe, and decided to change the name of the Network to 'Parliamentary Network women free from violence';
- Best practices for promoting gender equality in political parties (Rapporteur: Ms Stavrositu, Romania, EPP/CD): considered a revised memorandum and called on its members to ensure that the questionnaire prepared to collect information is completed and returned to the Secretariat;
- Gender equality and the status of women in the Council of Europe southern neighbourhood (Rapporteur: Ms Saïdi, Belgium, SOC): considered a revised memorandum;
- **Assembly's institutional representation**: appointed Mr Cilevičs (Latvia, SOC) as representative to the European Commission against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI) for 2012;
- Appointment of Rapporteurs: appointed:
 - Ms Mogherini Rebesani (Italy, SOC) as rapporteur on the Role of NGOs in countering nationalism, migrantophobia and xenophobia in Europe;
 - Ms Kyriakidou (Cyprus, SOC) as rapporteur on Muslim Women in Europe: for equal opportunities;
 - Ms Bourzai (France, SOC) as rapporteur for opinion on the **Request for partner for** democracy status with the Parliamentary Assembly submitted by the Parliament of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- **Membership of sub-committees**: approved of the membership of sub-committees as indicated in the appendix;
- Representation of the committee: appointed Ms Saïdi to participate in the 7th Meeting of the Committee of the Parties of the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings, Strasbourg, 30 January 2012;

- Date and place of the next meetings of the Committee: decided to hold its next meetings as follows:

 - Paris, 20 March 2012 (including meetings of sub-committees); Strasbourg, during the 2012 2nd part-session of the Assembly (23-27 April);
 - Paris, 4 June 2012;
 - (Paris, 5 June 2012, meeting of the Parliamentary Network women free from violence); Strasbourg, during the 2012 3rd part-session of the Assembly (25-29 June);

 - Paris, 10 September 2012;
 - Strasbourg, during the 2012 4th part-session of the Assembly (1-5 October);
 - Paris, 15 November 2012.
