Synopsis of the meeting held in Paris on 5 December 2013

The Committee on Equality and Non-Discrimination, meeting in Paris on 5 December 2013, with Ms Tina Acketoft (Sweden, ALDE) in the Chair,

as regards:

- Tackling racism in the police (Rapporteur: Mr David Davies, United Kingdom, EDG): heard a statement by the Rapporteur on his fact-finding visit to Germany (28-29 October 2013); approved a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution;
- A strategy to prevent racism and intolerance in Europe (Rapporteur: Mr Jonas Gunnarsson, Sweden, SOC): approved a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation, as amended;
- Activities of the Committee in 2013: heard a statement by its Chair and held an exchange of views on future priorities;
- Translation of the term "rapporteur" into French: held an exchange of views on the basis of a letter by Ms Liliane Maury-Pasquier (Switzerland, SOC) and a memorandum transmitted by the Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs;
- Evaluation of the Partnership for Democracy status in respect of the Palestinian National Council (Rapporteur for opinion: Ms Gülsün Bilgehan, Turkey, SOC): held a hearing on The status and human rights of women in Palestine with the participation of Ms Suheir Azzouni, Expert consultant;
- The situation and rights of traditional national minorities in Europe (Rapporteur: Mr Ferenc Kalmár, Hungary, EPP/CD): heard a statement by the Rapporteur on his fact-finding visit to Finland (5-7 November 2013) and held an exchange of views on the basis of a revised memorandum;
- **Prostitution and human trafficking in Europe** (Rapporteur: Mr José Mendes Bota, Portugal, EPP/CD): heard a statement by the Rapporteur on his fact-finding visits to Switzerland (25-26 September 2013) and the Netherlands (14-15 November 2013) and held an exchange of views on the basis of a memorandum;
- The situation of women in emerging democracies following the Arab revolutions (Rapporteur: Ms Fatiha Saïdi, Belgium, SOC): heard a statement by the Rapporteur, endorsed her request to conduct fact-finding visits to Egypt, Libya and Tunisia in the framework of the preparation of her report and decided to submit it to the Bureau of the Assembly for authorisation;

- Request for partner for democracy status with the Parliamentary Assembly submitted by the Parliament of the Kyrgyz Republic (Rapporteur: Ms Bernadette Bourzai, France, SOC): heard a statement by the Rapporteur based on a background paper and held an exchange of views;
- Focusing on the perpetrators to prevent violence against women (Rapporteur: Ms Athina Kyriakidou, Cyprus, SOC): considered an outline for a report;
- Equality and the crisis (Rapporteur: Mr Nikolaj Villumsen, Denmark, UEL): considered an outline for a report;
- Improving co-operation between National Human Rights Institutions (NHRIs) and Parliaments in addressing Equality and Non-Discrimination Issues (Rapporteur: Ms Katherine Zappone, Ireland, NR): considered an outline for a report;
- Violence against Women International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women: heard a review of activities carried out by its members;
- Dates and places of its next meetings: agreed to hold its next meetings as follows:
 - Strasbourg, during the 1st Part-Session 2014 of the Assembly (27-31 January);

 - Vienna, 4-5 March 2014 (subject to the Bureau's authorisation); Strasbourg, during the 2nd Part-Session 2014 of the Assembly (7-11 April); Strasbourg, during the 3rd Part-Session 2014 of the Assembly (23-27 June);
 - Strasbourg, during the 4th Part-Session 2014 of the Assembly (29 September-3 October).
