Synopsis of the meetings held in Strasbourg from 22 to 25 January 2007

The Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, meeting in Strasbourg

- on 22 January 2007 at 14 h, with first Mr Erik Jurgens (Netherlands, SOC), oldest member present, then with Mr Dick Marty (Switzerland, ALDE) in the Chair, as regards:
- *Election of the Committee's Bureau*: elected Mr Dick Marty (Switzerland, ALDE) Chairperson, Mr Erik Jurgens (Netherlands, SOC) 1st Vice-Chairperson, Mr György Frunda (Romania, EPP/CD) 2nd Vice-Chairperson and Mrs Herta Däubler-Gmelin (Germany, SOC) 3rd Vice-Chairperson by acclamation;
- Threats to the lives and freedom of expression of journalists: appointed Mr Paschal Mooney (Ireland, ALDE) Rapporteur for opinion;
- Member states' duty to cooperate with the European Court of Human Rights (Rapporteur: Mr Christos Pourgourides, Cyprus, EPP/CD): considered and approved a report and adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation with a view to presenting them at the Assembly's April 2007 part-session;

- on 23 January 2007 at 8 h 30, with Mr Dick Marty in the Chair, as regards:
- Child victims: stamping out all forms of violence, exploitation and abuse (Rapporteur: Mr Jean-Charles Gardetto, Monaco, EPP/CD): took position on the amendments tabled to the draft resolution and the draft recommendation;
- Reconstitution of sub-committees: reconstituted its four sub-committees: Sub-Committee on Human Rights, Sub-Committee on Rights of Minorities, Sub-Committee on Crime Problems and the Fight against Terrorism and Ad Hoc Sub-Committee on the Election of Judges to the European Court of Human Rights (see Appendix);
- Situation of human rights in Europe (Rapporteur: Mr Christos Pourgourides, Cyprus, EPP/CD): considered an introductory memorandum submitted by the Rapporteur, invited the members, following a proposal by the Rapporteur, to submit their possible comments in writing and instructed him to prepare, for its next meeting, elements falling within the Committee's competence for inclusion in the preliminary draft resolution and the preliminary draft recommendation:

- Respect for human rights in the fight against terrorism (Rapporteur: Mr Valery Grebennikov, Russian Federation, EDG): heard a statement by the Rapporteur and took note of the request made to the Bureau for an extension of his mandate until 30 June 2007;

- on 23 January 2007 at 14 h, with Mr Dick Marty in the Chair, as regards:
- Threats to the lives and freedom of expression of journalists (Rapporteur for opinion: Mr Paschal Mooney, Ireland, ALDE): considered a report tabled by the Committee on Culture, Science and Education, approved an opinion and eleven amendments to the draft recommendation and draft resolution, and instructed its Rapporteur to present them to the plenary assembly;
- **The United States of America and international law** (Rapporteur: Mr Tony Lloyd, United Kingdom, SOC): considered and approved a report and adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation with a view to presenting them at the Standing Committee in March 2007;
- Prosecution of offences falling within the jurisdiction of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (Rapporteur: Mr Tony Lloyd, United Kingdom, SOC): considered a supplementary introductory memorandum and authorised the Rapporteur to go to The Hague in February 2007 in order to meet the President, the Prosecutor and the Clerk of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia.

- on 25 January 2007 at 8 h 30, with Mr Dick Marty in the Chair, as regards:
- **Sub-Committee on Human Rights** (Chairperson: Mr Paschal Mooney): heard a report by the Chairperson of the Sub-Committee on the meeting held in Strasbourg on 24 January 2007, and endorsed the proposals of the Sub-Committee concerning the list of candidates to the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture (CPT) submitted by the parliamentary delegation of France;
- **Appointment of representatives of the Committee:** decided to propose the following nominations to the Bureau for 2007:
 - European Commission for Democracy through Law ("Venice Commission"): Mr Erik Jurgens (Netherlands, SOC)
 - o Council for Democratic Elections (of the Venice Commission): Mr Andreas Gross (Switzerland, SOC) and Mrs Meritxell Batet (Spain, SOC) as alternate
 - o European Commission against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI): Mr Boriss Cilevi□s (Latvia, SOC)
 - o Group of States against Corruption (GRECO): Mr Jaume Bartumeu Cassany (Andorra, SOC)
 - European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice (CEPEJ): Mr Michel Hunault (France, EDG)

- Colloquy: "Future developments of the European Court of Human Rights in the light of the Wise Persons' report" (organised by the San Marino Chairmanship of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe) (San Marino, 22-23 March 2007): Mrs Marie-Louise Bemelmans-Videc (Netherlands, EPP/CD)
- o 2nd meeting of the Group of Specialists on Human Rights Defenders (DH-S-DDH) (Strasbourg, 26-27 February 2007): Mr Holger Haibach (Germany, EPP/CD);
- Improving selection procedures for CPT members (Rapporteur: Mr Erol Aslan Cebeci, Turkey, EPP/CD): considered and approved a report and adopted a draft resolution, with a view to presenting them at the Standing Committee in March 2007;

- Non-ratification by the Russian Federation of Protocol No 14 to the European Convention
 on Human Rights: heard a statement by the Chairperson and the Director General of Human
 Rights, decided to propose to the Bureau that a delegation of the Committee on Legal Affairs
 and Human Rights, led by its Chairperson, go to Moscow to meet the members of the Duma's
 Legal Affairs Committee;
- The situation of national minorities in Voivodina and of the Romanian ethnic minority in Serbia Rapporteur: Mr Jürgen Herrmann, Germany, EPP/CD): took note of an information memorandum submitted by the Rapporteur and authorised him to undertake a second fact-finding visit in Serbia in March 2007;
- Next meetings:
 - Strasbourg, Monday 12 March 2007 at 9 h (Palais de l'Europe)
 - Strasbourg, during the 2nd part-session of 2007 (16-20 April)

The Sub-Committee on Human Rights (of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights), meeting in Strasbourg on 24 January 2007 at 14 h with first Mr Christos Pourgourides (Cyprus, EPP/CD), oldest member present, then Mr Paschal Mooney (Ireland, ALDE) in the Chair, as regards:

- **Election of the Sub-Committee's Bureau**: elected Mr Paschal Mooney (Ireland, ALDE) Chairperson, and Mr Jean-Charles Gardetto (Monaco, EPP/CD) Vice-Chairperson by acclamation;
- **European Committee for the Prevention of Torture (CPT)**: considered and approved its recommendations for the list of candidates to the CPT in respect of France;
- Access to medical treatment for former Minister of Economic Development Farhad Aliyev
 (Azerbaijan): state of health of Mr Aliyev: considered the written reply from the Chairperson
 of the delegation of Azerbaijan and instructed its Chairperson to reply that it was not satisfactory
 and to ask Azerbaijani authorities to allow Mr Aliyev to be examined by a doctor of his choice;
- Alleged summary execution in Ingushetia and secret prison in Grozny: took note that a
 reply was to be transmitted to the Sub-Committee for its next meeting;
- Alleged harassment of human rights defenders in Serbia: considered the written reply of the Chairperson of the Serbian delegation and decided to transmit it to the Monitoring Committee for information;
- **Next meeting:** left it to its Chairperson to decide the date and place of the next meeting.

The Sub-Committee on Crime Problems and the Fight against Terrorism (of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights), meeting on 24 January 2007 at 14 h 30, with first Mr Miguel Barceló (Spain, EPP/CD), oldest member present, and then Mr Jaume Bartumeu Cassany (Andorra, SOC) in the Chair, as regards:

- **Election of the Sub-Committee's Bureau**: re-elected by acclamation Mr Bartumeu Cassany (Andorra, SOC) Chairperson and elected Mr Michel Hunault (France, EDG) Vice-Chairperson;
- Next meeting: left it to its Chairperson to decide the date and place of the next meeting.
