Synopsis of the meeting held in Limassol (Cyprus) on 24 November 2008

The Sub-Committee on Human Rights (of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights), meeting in Limassol (Cyprus) on 24 November 2008 with Mr Jean-Charles Gardetto (Monaco, EPP/CD) in the Chair, as regards:
