Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 26-29 January 2015

The Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, meeting in Strasbourg from 26 to 29 January 2015:

- **on Monday 26 January 2015 at 2pm**, with Lord Tomlinson (United Kingdom, SOC), oldest member present, then Mr James Clappison (United Kingdom, EC) in the Chair, as regards:
- Election of the Bureau of the committee: elected, by acclamation, Mr James Clappison (United Kingdom, EC) as Chairperson, and Mr Michael McNamara (Ireland, SOC), Ms Mailis Reps (Estonia, ALDE), and Mr Şaban Díşli (Turkey, EPP/CD) as 1st, 2nd and 3rd Vice-Chairpersons, respectively;
- Constitution of sub-committees: agreed to constitute the Committee's three sub-committees, namely:
 - i. Sub-Committee on Crime Problems and the Fight against Terrorism
 - Sub-Committee on Human Rights
 - iii Sub-Committee on the implementation of judgments of the European Court of Human Rights
- Mass Surveillance (Rapporteur: Mr Pieter Omtzigt, Netherlands, EPP/CD): considered a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation;
- Human Rights in the North Caucasus: what follow-up to Resolution 1738 (2010)? (Rapporteur:
 Mr Michael McNamara, Ireland, SOC): considered an interim information report and decided to
 authorise a hearing with three representatives of the regional authorities, including the ombudsman's
 offices, subject to the availability of funds;

Other business

- High-Level Human Rights Conference in Brussels, 26 & 27 March 2015: authorised the Committee's Rapporteur on the "Implementation of judgments of the European Court of Human Rights" (Mr Klaas de Vries, Netherlands, SOC) to participate in this conference, pending an invitation and subject to the availability of funds;
- Nominations for the 2015 Václav Havel Human Rights Prize: was informed of the call for nominations for this prize and of the deadline for submitting nominations;
- **Dates of meetings**: took note of the changes of the dates of two of the Committee's meetings, now to be held on 18 March 2015 in Paris and on 19-20 May 2015 in Yerevan (Armenia);

- **on Tuesday 27 January 2015 at 8.30am with** Mr James Clappison (United Kingdom, EC), then Mr McNamara (Ireland, SOC) in the Chair, as regards:
- European institutions and human rights in Europe (Rapporteur: Mr Michael McNamara, Ireland, SOC): considered a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation;
- Drones and targeted killings: the need to uphold human rights (Rapporteur: Mr Arcadio Díaz Tejera, Spain, SOC): considered a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation:
- Composition of the sub-committees: approved the composition of the Committee's three sub-committees (see appendix);
- Appointment of rapporteurs:
 - **General Rapporteur on the Death Penalty:** re-appointed Ms Marietta Karamanli (France, SOC) for a second year;
 - Evaluation of the partnership for democracy in respect of the Parliament of the Kyrgyz Republic (for opinion) (Rapporteur for the Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy: Ms Tinatin Khidasheli (Georgia, ALDE): appointed Mr Michael McNamara (Ireland, SOC);
- Appointment of representatives of the committee: decided to propose to the Bureau the following nominations for representatives of the Committee to the following bodies for 2015:

- Participation of members in conferences, meetings, seminars etc.: heard feedback from Mr Díaz Tejera, who had attended the Venice Commission meeting on 12-13 December 2014, and Mr Beneyto, who had discussed his report on "Accountability of international organisations for human rights violations" with officials at the United Nations in New York in November 2014;
- With Mr Michael McNamara (Ireland, SOC) in the Chair, as regards:
- Statement proposed by Mr Yves Cruchten (Luxembourg, SOC), Rapporteur for the report on "How
 to prevent inappropriate restrictions on NGO activities in Europe": adopted a statement condemning
 the decision of the Russian Ministry of Justice to label the 2011 winner of the Assembly's Human
 Rights Prize, Komitet Protiv Pytok (Committee against Torture) as a "foreign agent";

- Thursday 29 January 2015 at 8.30am, as regards:
- Sub-Committee on Human Rights: heard a statement by the Vice-Chairperson Ms Inese Lībiņa-Egnere (Latvia, EPP/CD) with regard to the Sub-Committee's meeting held in Strasbourg on 28 January 2015 and endorsed the proposals of the Sub-Committee concerning the list of candidates to

the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture (CPT) submitted by the parliamentary delegation of Slovenia;

- Administrative Detention (Rapporteur: Mr Agustín Conde, Spain, EPP/CD): decided to postpone consideration of the revised introductory memorandum until the next meeting;
- Work programme: took note of the Committee's work programme for 2015 and agreed to the terms of reference for its sub-committees;
- Participation of members in conferences, meetings, seminars etc. (continuation): heard a report from Mr Robert Neill (United Kingdom, EC), its representative at GRECO meetings, which he had attended on 6-10 October and on 8-12 December 2014;

Other business (continuation)

- Opinion of the Court of Justice of the EU (CJEU) on the draft agreement on accession of the EU to the European Convention on Human Rights: took note of the CJEU's negative Opinion with regard to the draft agreement;
- Abusive use of the Interpol system: the need for more stringent legal safeguards (Rapporteur: Mr Bernd Fabritius, Germany, EPP/CD): on the proposal by the rapporteur, agreed to hold a hearing at the Committee's meeting in Yerevan on 19-20 May 2015 and to invite two experts, subject to the availability of funds;
- Foreign fighters in Syria (Rapporteur for the Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy: Mr Dirk Van der Maelen, Belgium, SOC): agreed to request the Bureau that the Committee be seized for opinion on this report;
- Exchange of views with President of the European Committee for the Prevention of Torture (CPT): agreed to a proposal by Mr Andreas Gross (Switzerland, SOC), Rapporteur on "The fate of critically ill prisoners in Turkish prisons", to invite Mr Latif Hüseynov, outgoing President of the CPT, to participate in an exchange of views at the Committee's next meeting in Paris on 18 March 2015;
- Mass surveillance (Rapporteur: Mr Pieter Omtzigt, Netherlands, EPP/CD): on a proposal by the Rapporteur, decided to ask the Bureau to invite Ms Christiane Taubira, Minister of Justice of France, to address the Assembly during the debate on "Mass Surveillance" foreseen for the April 2015 part-session;
- **Azerbaijan:** took note of a reply by Mr Samad Seyidov, Chairperson of the delegation of Azerbaijan, to the Chairperson's letter (requested by the Committee at its meeting on 10 December 2014) enquiring about the alleged harassment of members of the family of Ms Gulnara Akhundova as well as the arrests of civil society activists who had taken part in events organised by the Committee or its members during the Assembly's part-sessions in Strasbourg;
- Improving the protection of whistleblowers (Rapporteur: Mr Pieter Omtzigt, Netherlands, EPP/CD): held and exchange of views with EULEX whistleblower, Ms Maria Bamieh, former UK Prosecutor at EULEX, and a statement by Mr John Kiriakou, former CIA agent, read out by Ms Jesselyn Radack, Attorney, former ethics adviser to the United States Department of Justice and whistleblower (by live video-link). The Committee invited the rapporteur to write to the EU High Representative for External Relations and to the competent United States authorities inviting them to present their views regarding issues raised by the speakers at the hearing.
