Conference on the globalisation of migration processes (Meeting of the Sub-Committee on Migration, St Petersburg, 3-4 April 2008): held an exchange of views with Mrs Yevgenia VLADIMIROVA, Secretariat of the Inter-parliamentary Assembly of Member Nations of the CIS and Mr Denis ZHUK, Deputy Head of the Directorate of Inter-Parliamentary Cooperation on Foreign Policy on the programme of the Conference;

- Europe's response to humanitarian disasters – follow-up to Resolution 1586 (2007): held an exchange of views with Mrs Joachime NASON and Mrs Julia STEWART-DAVID, European Commission DG ECHO;
