The Committee on Migration, Refugees and Population, meeting in Paris, on 13 September 2011, with Mr Christopher Chope (United Kingdom, EDG) in the Chair, as regards:

- Undocumented migrant children in an irregular situation: a real cause for concern (Rapporteur: Mr Pedro Agramunt, Spain, EPP/CD): approved a report and unanimously adopted a draft recommendation, as amended;
- The activities of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) in 2010-2011 (Rapporteur for contribution: Ms Sandra Osborne, United Kingdom, SOC): appoved a draft contribution:
- The portrayal of migrants and refugees during election campaigns (Rapporteur: Ms Daphné Dumery, Belgium, NR): in the absence of the Rapporteur, decided to postpone this item to its next meeting;
- **Demographic trends in Europe: turning challenges into opportunities** (Rapporteur: Ms Nursuna Memecan, Turkey, ALDE): considered a memorandum, held an exchange of views with Mr Nico van NIMWEGEN, Deputy Director, Netherlands Interdisciplinary Demographic Institute (NIDI) and decided to propose to the Bureau of the Assembly to invite the executive Director of the United Nations Population Fund and Under-Secretary General of the United Nations, Dr Babatunde Osotimehin, to address the Parliamentary Assembly when this report will be debated;
- The situation of IDPs and returnees in the North Caucasus region (Rapporteur: Mr Nikolaos Dendias, Greece, EPP/CD): heard a statement by the Rapporteur on his forthcoming fact-finding visit to Moscow and to the North Caucasus region (18-24 September 2011) and held an exchange of views with Ms Nadine WALICKI, Internal Displacement Monitoring Centre (IDMC) and Mr Ion SMOCHINA, Head of Caucasus Desk, Danish Refugee Council;
- **The situation of Roma in Europe: movement and migration** (Rapporteur: Ms Annette Groth, Germany, UEL): in the absence of the Rapporteur, decided to postpone this item to its next meeting;
- Lives lost in the Mediterranean sea: who is responsible? (Rapporteur: Ms Tineke Strik, Netherlands, SOC): in the absence of the Rapporteur, was informed on the programme of her fact-finding visit to Rome (6-7 September 2011) and held an exchange of views;
