20 June 2005

**The Bureau of the Assembly**, meeting on Monday 20 June 2005 in Strasbourg with Mr René van der Linden, President of the Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- *3<sup>rd</sup> Part of the 2005 Ordinary Session (Strasbourg, 20-24 June 2005):*
  - i. updated the draft order of business;
  - ii. took note that the socialist group, which requested the current affairs debate on “the Situation in the Republics of Central Asia”, would propose a representative to open the debate;
- *Observation of elections:*
  - i. Parliamentary elections in Albania (3 July 2005):
    - . took note of the memorandum prepared by Mr Smorawinski (EPP/CD) on the pre-electoral mission to Albania from 30 May to 1 June 2005;
    - . agreed to invite Mrs Eliska Wagnerova, expert of the Venice Commission, to assist the ad hoc committee of the Assembly to observe these elections;
  - ii. Parliamentary elections in Azerbaijan (November 2005):
    - . set up an Ad Hoc Committee to observe these elections composed of 40 members (d'Hondt system: SOC: 14; EPP/DC: 13; LDR: 6; EDG: 5; UEL: 2);
    - . decided that a pre-electoral mission should take place one month before the election at the latest, composed of five members, one from each political group who are at the same time members of the Ad Hoc Committee;
- *Progress report of the Bureau of the Assembly and of the Standing Committee (29 April – 20 June 2005):* approved the Progress report;

  - . Sub-Committee on Refugees (of the Committee on Migration, Refugees and population), Skopje, (FYROM), 17 – 18 October 2005;

. *Composition of the Ad Hoc Committee on the implementation of paragraph 5 of Resolution 1416 (2004) on the conflict over the Nagorno-Karabakh region dealt with by the OSCE Minsk Conference:* following the decision to include in the Ad Hoc Committee one representative of the main opposition party from, respectively, the delegation of Armenia and Azerbaijan to the Assembly, the Bureau decided to include Mr Kocharyan from the delegation of Armenia and Mr Mollazade from the delegation of Azerbaijan as members of the ad hoc committee;

- *Implementation of Paragraph 6 of Resolution 1376 (2004) on Cyprus:* took note of the letters from two Turkish Cypriot political parties communicating to the President of the Assembly the names of the two “elected representatives of the Turkish Cypriot community” i.e. Mr Nami (Republican Turkish Party) and Mr Özgürgün (National Unity Party), to be submitted to the Assembly for approval in accordance with the decision of the Bureau on 4 October 2004.

- *Fact-finding visit to the Chechen republic (Russian Federation):* took note of the letter of the Chairman of the Political Affairs Committee informing the Bureau about the discussions in this committee concerning a possible fact-finding visit to the Chechen Republic.

- *Information:* took note of the information by the President of the Assembly, the Secretary General and the Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe and the Secretary General of the Assembly;

- *Date and place of the next meetings:* decided to hold the following meetings:
