**The Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men**, meeting in Paris on 5 December 2008, with Mr Mendes Bota (Portugal, EPP/CD), 1<sup>st</sup> Vice-Chairperson, in the Chair:

#### as regards:

- Feminicides (Rapporteur: Ms Err, Luxembourg, SOC): in the absence of the Rapporteur, considered a draft report, amended and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation with a view to presenting the report for debate at the 2009 first part-session (26-30 January);
- Abduction and illegal confinement of women and girls in the name of practices contrary to human rights (Rapporteur: Ms Papadopoulos, Cyprus, ALDE):
  - heard a statement by the Rapporteur on the fact-finding mission in Morocco (28-30 October 2008);
  - following a proposal of the Rapporteur, agreed to change the title of the report as follows: Action to combat gender-based human rights violations, including abduction of women and girls;
  - considered a draft report, amended and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation with a view to presenting the report for debate at the 2009 second partsession (27-30 April);
- The rights of today's girls, the rights of tomorrow's women (Rapporteur: Ms Cliveti, Romania, SOC): in the absence of the Rapporteur, held a hearing with the following experts:
  - Ms Amaya Gillespie, Director at UNICEF
  - Ms Christiane Spiel, Professor for educational psychology and evaluation at the University of Vienna (Austria)
  - Ms Carrie Paechter, Professor of Education at Goldsmiths University of London (UK)
  - Ms Inete Ielite, Chairperson of the Board of the NGO "Children's Forum of Latvia" (Latvia)
- Nomination of candidates and election of judges to the European Court of Human Rights (Rapporteur for opinion: Ms Err, Luxembourg, SOC): in the absence of the Rapporteur, started to prepare the Committee's opinion;
- Double discrimination of Romani women and girls (Rapporteur for information: Ms Stantcheva, Bulgaria, ALDE): decided to ask the Bureau for an extension of the deadline of this report until 30 June 2009;
