- Council for Democratic Elections (Venice Commission): appointed Mr Jurgens (Netherlands, SOC) as the Committee's representative and Mr Pourgourides (Cyprus, EPP) as an alternate;
- Terrorism: a threat to democracies (Rapporteur for opinion: Mr Bartumeu Cassany, Andorra, SOC): considered a report tabled by the Political Affairs Committee, adopted an amendment and decided to propose the referral of the report back to the Committee;

- European Committee for the Prevention of Torture (CPT): considered and agreed on recommendations for candidatures to the CPT in respect of Andorra and Malta;
- Abolition of the death penalty in Council of Europe observer States (Rapporteur: Mrs Wohlwend, Liechtenstein, EPP): declassified the report of the conference held in Springfield and Washington (USA) on 9-11 April 2003, heard a report on the preparation of the seminars on the death penalty in the United States of America and Japan, and on the parliamentary conference on effective criminal justice to be held in Paris after these seminars have taken place;
