Synopsis of the joint-meeting held in London (United Kingdom) on 26 March 2018

The **Sub-Committee on Refugee and Migrant Children and Young People**, jointly meeting in London with the **Sub-Committee on Culture, Diversity and Heritage**, with **Alexander [the Earl of] Dundee** (United Kingdom, EC) and **Ms Nino Gogvadze** (Georgia, EC) in the Chair,

- **on Monday, 26 March 2018 at 9 a.m.**, as regards:
 - **Academic mobility in the United Kingdom**: held a hearing with the participation of Ms Nicky Rogers, Head of Migration Analysis & Development of Sources and Ms Amelia Ash, Senior Research Officer, Migration Statistics Division, UK Office for National Statistics, Ms Julie Allen, Director of Policy and Services, UK Council for International Student Affairs, London, Ms Eleanor Jubb, Policy Analyst, Universities UK International, Ms Hannah Wiskin, Deputy Director for Higher Education EU/International Policy and Prevent Unit, Department for Education, UK, and Lord Karan Bilimoria, Chancellor of Birmingham University;
 - **Encouraging the movement of international students across Europe** (*Rapporteur: Alexander [the Earl of] Dundee, United Kingdom, EC*): heard a presentation of the report by its rapporteur and held an exchange of views with Ms Lucie Cerna, Research Associate, Centre on Migration, Policy and Society (COMPAS), Oxford;
 - **The implications of Brexit for migration**: held an exchange of views on aspects concerning children and young people;
 - **The value of cultural heritage in a democratic society** (*Rapporteur: Alexander [the Earl of] Dundee, United Kingdom, EC*): held a hearing with the participation of Mr Andy Pratt, Professor of Cultural Economy at the Centre for Culture and the Creative Industries, City University, London, Ms Beatriz Garcia, Director of the Institute of Cultural Capital, Liverpool, Mr Guy Nicholson, Councillor, Borough of Hackney, London, Ms Andrea Stark, Director of Employment, Skills and Culture, Borough of Islington, London, and Ms Lorna Lee, Head of Cultural and Heritage Services, Borough of Waltham Forest, London;
 - **Visit to the Tate Modern Museum of International modern and contemporary art**: heard a presentation of the museum as an example of rehabilitation of industrial heritage, and held an exchange of views on the impact of the museum in the redevelopment plan of the SE1 area of London and local involvement in shaping cultural policies, with the participation of Mr Donald Hyslop, Head of Regeneration & Community Partnerships, Tate Modern, and Ms Anna Cutler, Director of Learning, Tate Modern;

- **Next meeting:** decided to leave it to the chairperson of each sub-committee to convene the next meeting.
