The Committee on Rules of Procedure and Immunities, meeting in Strasbourg on 2 April 2003, first with Mr Holovaty (Ukraine, LDR), Chairman and then with Mr Vis (United Kingdom, SOC), 1st Vice-Chairman, in the Chair:

As regards

- *Immunities of members of the Parliamentary Assembly, Rapporteur: Mr Olteanu Romania, SOC: took position on four amendments submitted on the draft Recommendation and the draft Resolution;*
- *Procedure concerning elections held by the Assembly (except those of the President and Vice-Presidents of the Assembly), Rapporteur: Mr Vis, United Kingdom, SOC: held an exchange of views based on a working document by the rapporteur and asked him to present a draft report at the next meeting;*
- *Consultation of the Committee on Rules of Procedure and Immunities on the follow-up to be given to a Motion for a Recommendation on the Council of Europe activities; held a preliminary exchange of views based on a note presented by the Chairman;*
- *Increase of the number of seats of the Monitoring Committee: appointed Mr Einarsson (Sweden, UEL) as rapporteur;*
- *Change of name of the Committee on Migration, Refugees and Demography: appointed Mr Akçam (Turkey, EPP) as rapporteur;*
- took note of a letter from the President of the Parliamentary Assembly concerning guidelines for the distribution of rapporteurship in Assembly committees;
- decided to meet during the next part-session of the Assembly (23-27 June 2003).
