**Synopsis  
of the meeting held in Strasbourg  
on 24-27 April 2017**

**The Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development**, meeting in Strasbourg:

- **Monday, 24 April 2017, at 2 pm**, with Ms Stella Kyriakides (Cyprus, EPP/CD), Chairperson, in the Chair, as regards:
  - ***The employment rights of domestic workers, especially women, in Europe*** (*Rapporteur: Mr Viorel Badea, Romania, EPP/CD*): considered a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution as amended, with a view to presenting the report for debate at the Standing Committee meeting on 30 May 2017 in Prague;
  - ***Striking a balance between the best interest of the child and the need to keep the families together*** (*Rapporteur: Mr Valeriu Ghiletschi, Republic of Moldova, EPP/CD*): considered an introductory memorandum and authorised the rapporteur to undertake fact-finding visits to Norway and Austria;
  - ***Committee's work programme and priorities:***
  - *appointed rapporteur as follows:*
    - Migration as an opportunity for European development (*for opinion*): Ms Petra De Sutter (Belgium, SOC), and heard from her a declaration of absence of conflict of interest;

- United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) Ministerial Conference on Ageing, “A Sustainable Society for All Ages: Realizing the potential of living longer”, 21-22 September 2017, Lisbon, Portugal: Lord George Foulkes (United Kingdom, SOC);
- International conference on the occasion of the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Oviedo Convention, 24-25 October 2017, Strasbourg, France: Ms Liliane Maury Pasquier (Switzerland, SOC);
- United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP23), 6-17 November 2017, Bonn, Germany (*participation limited to three days*): Lord John Prescott (United Kingdom, SOC), in his capacity as Rapporteur on Climate change and implementation of the Paris Agreement, and as second representative (*at no cost to the Assembly*) Mr Cezar Florin Preda (Romania, EPP/CD);

  - **Parental authority conflicts** (*Rapporteur: Ms Martine Mergen, Luxembourg, EPP/CD*): held an exchange of views with Ms Juliane Hirsch, Consultant on Private International Law and International Family Law;
  - **Detention of Palestinian minors in Israeli prisons** (*Rapporteur: Ms Liliane Maury Pasquier, Switzerland, SOC*): heard a video statement by Ms June Kunugi, Special Representative, UNICEF, and held an exchange of views with:
    - Mr Khaled Quzmar, General Director, “Defense for Children International - Palestine (DCIP)”;
    - Ms Sarit Michaeli, International Advocacy Officer, “B’Tselem - The Israeli Information Center for Human Rights in the Occupied Territories”;
- **Tuesday, 25 April 2017, at 2 pm** with Ms Stella Kyriakides (Cyprus, EPP/CD), Chairperson, in the Chair, as regards:
  - **Fighting income inequality as a means of fostering social cohesion and economic development** (*Rapporteur: Mr Andrej Hunko, Germany, UEL*): noted that no amendments had been tabled;
  - **“New generation” trade agreements and their implications for social rights, public health and sustainable development** (*Rapporteur: Mr Geraint Davies, United Kingdom, SOC*): heard a statement by the Rapporteur on the letter received from Ms Cecilia Malmström, EU Commissioner for Trade, and authorised the Rapporteur to reply to the Commissioner on the Committee’s behalf;
  - **The case against a Council of Europe legal instrument on involuntary measures in psychiatry**: heard a statement by the Chairperson on the follow-up to Recommendation 2091 (2016); considered and adopted comments on the revised Draft Additional Protocol concerning the protection of human rights and dignity of persons with mental disorder with regard to involuntary placement and involuntary treatment, and its revised Draft Explanatory Report, for transmission to the Council of Europe Committee on Bioethics (DH-BIO); and endorsed the Chairperson’s supplementary comments thereon; in the absence of a quorum, encouraged members to sign the motion for a recommendation on “Protecting the rights of people with psychosocial disabilities with regard to involuntary measures in psychiatry”;
  - **Changes in the Sub-Committees**: approved the changes in the Sub-Committees as indicated in the appendix (*new members added on 25 and 27 April 2017 are indicated in bolded italics*);
